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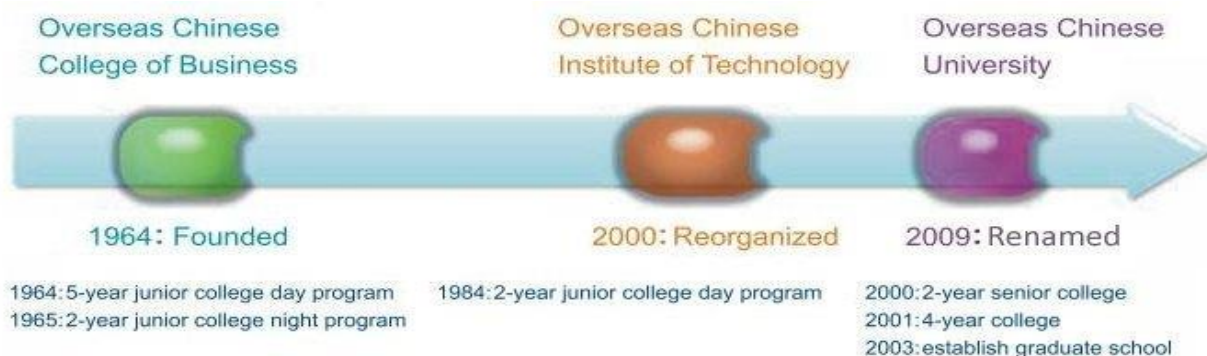

1. Introduction to Overseas Chinese University



Overseas Chinese University (OCU), founded in 1964 with the motto “honesty, sincerity, righteousness, and trustworthiness,” values interdisciplinary education and business. In central Taiwan, OCU is a technological university with a tradition of excellence. Research and the application of business and languages have been the center of OCU's development and strength. Tourism, catering services, and design are its most recent specialty areas. The ultimate goal of OCU is to actively develop school features and become the best private university of technology.

OCU not only maintains its good reputation and high status; it also actively develops both cross-strait and international communication, promotes students' values and broadens their vision, and trains students to have professional skills, so they can enjoy learning and find employment easily.

OCU has become an internationalized school and continually makes efforts to support cooperative arrangements with famous schools in the United States of America, England, Japan, Austria, the Czech Republic, southeast Asia, and China. OCU has signed many international academic exchange and cooperation agreements implementing double degrees, teacher exchanges, student exchanges, English Summer Overseas Travel, academic exchanges, and seminars organized for various types of international exchange activities. These provide international students access to the school for further studies and increase multi-channel opportunities for international academic exchanges between teachers. The goals are to broaden students' global perspectives, improve their language skills, and promote cultural exchanges and citizen diplomacy.

2. Eligibility

(1) Nationality

- a. International students shall be defined as individuals who have never held Republic of China (Taiwan) nationality nor have had Overseas Chinese student status.
- b. Individuals who hold foreign nationalities and have stayed abroad for more than 6 years (up to August 1, 2017) and who are qualified for one of the following situations are considered as international students.
 - (a) Individuals holding both foreign and R.O.C. nationalities but have never had household registration in Taiwan.
 - (b) Individuals holding foreign nationality and once had R.O.C. nationality but his or her household registration had been revoked by the Ministry of Interior for at least 8 years (up to August 1, 2017).
 - (c) The above individuals who have never held Overseas Chinese student status or studied in Taiwan nor have received a student status by University Entrance Committee for Overseas Chinese in the enrollment year.

Students who are recommended by foreign governments, organizations, or schools, according to educational cooperation agreements, are approved by the educational supervisory institutions, and have never held Republic of China (Taiwan) household registration.
- c. An applicant holding foreign nationality, concurrently holding a permanent residence status in Hong Kong or Macao, has never been registered as part of a household in Taiwan and, at the time of application, has continuously resided in Hong Kong, Macao, or another foreign country (overseas) for no less than 6 years is qualified to apply for admission under these regulations.
- d. An applicant who is a former citizen of Mainland China, currently holds a foreign nationality, has never been registered as part of a household in Taiwan and, at the time of application, has continuously resided overseas for no less than 6 years is qualified to apply for admission under these regulations.
- e. The term “overseas” as prescribed in Paragraph b, c, and d is limited to countries or regions other than Mainland China, Hong Kong, and Macau. The phrase “continuously reside overseas” means that an individual may stay in Taiwan for no more than a total of 120 days per calendar year. If the period of continuously living overseas does not conform to an academic year, the amount of time spent overseas shall be calculated as a maximum of 120 days.

The only exceptions to this method of calculation are for those who fulfill one of the following requirements with written supported proof:

- (a) Attended overseas youth training courses organized by the Overseas Compatriot Affairs Council or technique training classes accredited by the Ministry of Education.
- (b) Attended a Mandarin Chinese language center at a university/college of which foreign student recruitment is approved by the Ministry, and to which the total length of stay is less than 2 years.
- (c) Exchange students whose length of total exchange is less than 2 years.
- (d) An Internship in Taiwan which has been approved by an authorized central government agency, to which the total length of stay is less than 2 years.
- (e) [**Transfer students**] International students who began their studies at another Taiwanese university, but are applying to continue a degree program at OCU.

(2) Education Background

International students who graduate from a high school, college, or university which is recognized by the Taiwan Ministry of Education are eligible to apply for admission.

- a. Students who graduated from high schools are eligible to apply for four-year undergraduate programs.
- b. Students with bachelor degrees are eligible to apply for graduate studies in master's degree programs.
- c. Individuals who meet the regulations stipulated in the Standards for Recognition of Equivalent Educational Level as Qualified for Entering University shall be considered to have an adequate level of education to register for the new student enrollment entrance examination.

* Those having completed study at an equivalent foreign or Hong Kong/Macau high school which is equal to the sophomore or a senior high school in Taiwan may apply to the undergraduate program at OCU and the University shall increase 12 credits for graduation to complete their study.

- d. [**Transfer students**] International students who began their studies at a public or private Taiwanese university, or a foreign university recognized by the Ministry of Education, but are applying to continue at OCU should note the following provisions:
 - (a) Applicants who have completed two or more semesters at a different educational institution are eligible to transfer to the first semester of the

- second year at OCU.
- (b) Applicants who have completed three or more semesters at a different educational institution are eligible to transfer to the second semester of the second year at OCU.
 - (c) Applicants who have completed four or more semesters at a different educational institution are eligible to transfer to the first semester of the third year at OCU.
 - (d) Applicants who have completed five or more semesters at a different educational institution are eligible to transfer to the second semester of the third year at OCU.

3. Application Instructions

- (1) Application Deadline: 6/16/2017 (Fall semester) or 12/8/2017 (Spring semester).
- (2) How to Apply: Applications are accepted only by mail.

- Note** : Incomplete or illegible applications will be rejected.
- (3) Application Fee: (We do not accept applications from those who do not pay the application fee.)
 - a. \$42 USD or \$1,300 TWD.
 - b. If paying in TWD, the applicant will have to purchase a postal money order of \$1,300 TWD. The recipient of the postal money order is Overseas Chinese University (written in Chinese 僑光科技大學). Send the postal money order along with all of the application documents to OCU.
 - c. If paying in USD, the application fee should be remitted to OCU's bank account (Remittance fees should be paid by applicants). Please enclose a copy of your bank's electronic transfer receipt along with the other documents.

(4) Required Documents

- a. A checklist of required documents. (see **Appendix 1**)
- b. One application form with a 2-inch personal photo attached. The photos should be taken within 3 months of application submission. (see **Appendix 2**)
- c. Academic credentials:

The highest-level diploma and transcript issued by an overseas academic institution. These documents must be authenticated by a ROC embassy, consulate, representative office, another agency authorized by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs (hereinafter referred to as “Taiwan’s overseas agencies”), or verified by institutes established or appointed by, or through a private agency commissioned by, the Executive Yuan. (A copy of the translation in Chinese or English is necessary if the original diploma and transcript are in a language other than Chinese or English.)

(a) Academic credentials from Mainland China: The Regulations Governing the Accreditation of Schools in Mainland China shall apply.

(b) Academic credentials from Hong Kong or Macao: Academic Credential Verification and Accreditation Methods adopted in Hong Kong and Macao shall apply.

(c) Academic credentials from other areas:

i. Academic credentials earned at overseas Taiwan schools or Taiwan schools in Mainland China shall be regarded as the same as those at domestic schools with equivalent levels.

ii. Academic credentials referred to the preceding 2 items shall be subject to the Regulations Regarding the Assessment and Recognition of Foreign Academic Credentials for Institutions of Higher Education. However, academic credentials earned from institutes or branches established in Mainland China by foreign schools shall require public notarization in Mainland China and be verified and examined by an institute established or appointed by, or through a private agency commissioned by the Executive Yuan.

(d) [**Transfer students**] Transfer students must submit a proof of study certificate, as well as an original transcript from the previous university.

* If the verification process is not completed before the application deadline, a signed deposition related to application documents (see **Appendix 5**) must be submitted with the application.

** At the time of registration, students must provide the original academic degree and transcript verified by a Taiwan overseas representative office, or verified by an institute established or appointed by, or through a private agency commissioned by, the Executive Yuan. If the related certificates cannot be submitted on time, the admissions offer will be revoked.

- d. A financial statement with a minimum balance of \$3,000 USD or a copy of a scholarship award notification (Please select one of the following payment methods).
- (a) Photocopy of a financial statement that demonstrates financial sustainability for study in Taiwan (issued by a financial institution within the past three months).
 - (b) Proof of full scholarship provided by a government agency, university, college or private organization.

* If the financial statement is in the name of a parental guardian of the applicant, a public notarization of financial guarantee is also required.

- e. A Chinese or English study plan including learning motives, expected date of graduation, and expectation for the future.
- f. Two letters of recommendation. (For graduate program applicants only.)
- g. Certificate of Chinese Proficiency: TOCFL Band B, Level 3 proficiency or other relevant certificates. (Native Chinese speakers are exempt from this stipulation.)
- h. Affidavit. (see **Appendix 3**)
- i. Letter of Authority. (see **Appendix 4**)
- j. Application fee: A copy of your bank's electronic transfer receipt or a postal money order.
- k. Verification of nationality or copy of passport (front page).
- l. Individuals holding foreign nationality and currently holding or previously holding R.O.C. nationality shall submit documentation to prove residence for a period of at least 6 years at the time of application.
- m. Individuals holding a foreign nationality and once had R.O.C. nationality but have never had household registration in Taiwan shall submit certificate issued by the Ministry of Interior to prove his/her duration of stay for more than 8 years.

4. Important Reminders

- (1) Applicant has never studied in the ROC as an Overseas Chinese student.
- (2) International students applying for schools in Taiwan shall be limited to one application only.
- (3) Applicants can apply for only one department and should make sure that they are qualified by checking all criteria provided by the department.
- (4) Applicants who are not proficient in Mandarin should take extra related language courses.
- (5) An international student who has completed a bachelor's degree or a higher degree in Taiwan and can apply for a master's program, provided that a graduate certificate and transcript for each consecutive semester issued from the educational institutions in Taiwan is enclosed.
- (6) International students who have graduated from private high schools, lower grade schools for international residents in Taiwan, bilingual programs affiliated with senior high schools, or from a foreign curriculum department and classes at private senior high schools or below must submit credentials and transcripts for each academic semester to apply for admission.
- (7) International students who have been forced to withdraw from any educational institution in Taiwan are not allowed to apply for admission. Should any applicant be determined to have withdrawn from any educational institute in Taiwan, the applicant's student status will be revoked immediately.
- (8) International students may not apply for continuing education bachelor's degree programs, part-time master's degree programs, or programs that are restricted to night or weekend classes. International students who have obtained legal resident status in Taiwan are exempt from this stipulation.
- (9) All the submitted application information should be clear and without mistakes. Applicants should be held fully responsible for any consequences arising from errors in application materials.
- (10) Applicants should check all the required documents fully submitted to OCU. If any of the above required documents are incomplete or delayed by postal delivery, causing the application to be incomplete, the applicants should be fully responsible for the consequences.
- (11) All the submitted application documents should be accurate and valid. If any of the above documents are found to be false, the applicant should be expelled and their diploma revoked if graduated.

(12) Submitted documents will not be returned. Please make copies for your own reference.

7. Scholarship / Financial Aid Information

- (1) OCU International Student Scholarship
 - a. The various awards are as follows:
 - (a) Level I Award: Tuition and student fees covered; free campus housing provided.
 - (b) Level II Award: Tuition and student fees covered.
 - (c) Level III Award: Half of tuition and student fees covered; free campus housing provided.
 - (d) Level IV Award: Half of tuition and student fees covered.
 - (e) Level V Award: Free campus housing provided.
 - b. Prospective international students have priorities.
 - c. Awards are provided for one academic year; all recipients must be re-apply annually.
- (2) OCU Overseas Student Financial Aid
 - a. Every qualified student can obtain \$3,000 TWD per month for up to ten months per year.
 - b. Prospective overseas students have priorities.
- (3) Students must choose either Scholarship or Financial Aid.
- (4) Undergraduate students may obtain aid for four years. Graduate students may obtain aid for two years.

9. Residence Fee & Living Expenses

(1) Student dormitory

- a. In order to be admitted to the dormitory, students must submit a health report. Each dormitory room houses 4 to 6 students.

- a. The fees for processing the Alien Resident Certificate (ARC), health insurance (see Notes (a) & (b)), physical examination and opening a bank account are approximately \$8,000 TWD (258 USD).

Notes:

- (a) Students should accept the insurance arrangements made by OCU after registration.
- (b) Six months after registration, students are required to have National

Health Insurance.

- b. The estimated living cost at OCU is about \$10,000 TWD (323 USD) per month, including transportation and other personal expenses.
- c. All prices are calculated and charged in TWD. Prices mentioned in USD are for reference only.

10. Remarks

- (1) Acceptance letters or admissions notices do not guarantee visa issuance. Visas are approved by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs.
- (2) After being offered admission, students must prepare all documents and credentials that can prove their requirements for enrollment. If the documents or credentials students offer are found false, students will be dismissed from the school, will not be granted any school certificates, and will be held criminally responsible. If students are found offering false documents or credentials after they have graduated, their academic degree will be cancelled. School will publicly cancel students' requirements for graduation.
- (3) International students are required to be covered by the six-month insurance arrangements made by OCU starting from the date of registration. Students who do not accept the insurance will not be allowed to continue enrollment.
- (4) Applicants, in accordance with the Personal Data Protection Law, will allow OCU to use their personal information for application and enrollment at OCU. OCU will keep applicants' personal information for the use of enrollment evaluation only. By submitting the application forms, applicants grant the school use of their personal information in aspects related to enrollment. Applicants' full names will be shown on the list of successful candidates. Their personal information will then be transferred to Registration.
- (5) International students will lose their international student status and shall be expelled from OCU if they obtain Taiwan residency or Republic of China citizenship status during their course of study.
- (6) Any details not mentioned or regulated in this prospect must conform to the laws or policy of the Ministry of Education, Overseas Chinese University Admission Committee, and Overseas Chinese University Academic Affairs Division.
- (7) **If there should be any discrepancy or contradiction, the Chinese version prevails.**
